

Pharmaceutical vs Herbal Medicine


Parameter	Pharmaceutical	Herbal or Atagoro	
Medicine constituents	Usually one or few synthetic actives	Many natural actives	
Source	Total/partial synthesis, bio- technology, by man	Plants or other natural sources	
Treatment focus	One disease one drug, so you find someone taking too many tablets	Multifactorial, one or two herbs are usually enough	
Side effects	Part of treatment	Rare and usually mild	
Cost	Not affordable to Majority	Almost costless

Case of Large Wound treated using JenaCure

A 9 year old boy, got injured on the leg while playing football and after 4-5 days, the leg started swelling and paining and he was taken to a clinic.

- An I&D was done to drain pass but it kept recurring and several I&D's were administered.
- The child was taken to Nsambya hospital, amputation recommended at a cost of UGX 800,000. which the parents could not afford.
- The Child was then taken to Mengo hospital and amputation was recommended at 600,000ug.shs but still the parents could not afford
- They were then referred to Mulago NRH and amputation recommended for free
- However a friend of the child's mother opted for Natural chemotherapeutics Research Laboratory and brought the mother and child to us.



Day 1 - the boy was brought with plaster





Day 1 after plaster removed and herbal treatment initiated





After 2 weeks of herbal formula application





Complete wound healing after 3 weeks of herbal formula application





One month of treatment with Herbal formulation



The boy is now at school with his two legs and the Mother says he is able to kick the ball again.



Why do Natural Medicines sometimes fail to work ?

Correct dose & correct Disease is very important

- No drug treats all diseases or all patients
- > Stability of the active components in the formulation/products
 - Compounds breakdown and lose curative powers
- Quality control & Quality Assurance
 - Batch to batch consistency is a challenge in natural medicine production


